<b>British Afghan Women's Society</b>	<p>British Afghan Women's Society was founded by a group of women to provide support to Afghan women living in London. <b>Federation of Iraqi Refugees</b>	<p>Federation of Iraqi Refugees is a self-help organisation, which aims to provide support and assistance to Iraqi refugees and asylum seekers, particularly those held in detention centres.</p> <p>The Trust has provided funding towards the salary of a part-time Development Worker, who will provide one-to-one support and advice to Iraqi detainees in the main detention centres in London and the surrounding area.</p>	14,800	2 Islington

Somali and Somaliland London Community	Somali and Somaliland London Community provides a range of services for the Somali community, including drop-in advice sessions, supplementary education classes, youth activities and a police advisory surgery.  The Trust has provided funding towards the salary of the Co-ordinator to help run the organisation and to deliver its current services.	20,000	2	Lewisham
Somali Eye Media	Somali Eye Media is a community group which produces a magazine and a weekly radio programme. The activities provide information to the Somali community, highlights issues they are concerned about and showcases positive role models from within the community. Its activities include advice and workshops on health, social and recreational activities for young women. Andisheh School	Andisheh Persian Language School was set by a group of volunteers, including parents to run a Saturday supplementary and mother-tongue school for Farsi and Persian-speaking children and dual heritage families living in Barnet.  The Trust has provided funding towards the costs of mother-tongue and supplementary classes. The grant will also enable it to run educational awareness workshops for parents.	16,000	2	Barnet
Ardhmeria	Ardhmeria is an Albanian community group providing supplementary and mother-tongue classes across five London boroughs. Centre 4M	<p>Centre 4M runs a Saturday school providing classes in English, maths and science.
